

## NOTICE TO MEMBERS

**TO: The Members of the LM Australian Income Fund ARSN 133 497 917**

John Richard Park and Ginette Dawn Muller are the liquidators of LM Investment Management Limited (in liquidation) (receivers appointed) ("LMIM"), which remains the responsible entity of the LM Australian Income Fund ARSN 133 497 917 ("AIF").

**TAKE NOTICE that:-**

1. John Richard Park and Ginette Dawn Muller, as the liquidators of LMIM have applied to the Supreme Court of Queensland for the determination and fixing of their remuneration as liquidators of LMIM for the period from 1 August, 2013 to 30 September, 2015; and for a direction that they be authorised to draw that sum from the Scheme Property of the AIF, is as follows:-
  - (a) in respect of work directly referable to the AIF, in the amount of \$499,622.96 (plus GST); and
  - (b) in the amount of \$137,212.71 (plus GST) in respect of the balance, which amount the Applicants claim represents a proportionate amount of such work relative to the capital contributed to the Scheme Property of the AIF, relative to the capital contributed to the other funds of which LMIM is the responsible entity or the trustee ("Other Funds").
2. John Richard Park and Ginette Dawn Muller, as the former administrators of LMIM, have applied to the Supreme Court of Queensland for a direction that their remuneration as administrators of LMIM for the period 19 March, 2013 to 31 July, 2013 shall be borne by the AIF and paid from the Scheme Property of the AIF, as follows:-
  - (a) In respect of work directly referable to the AIF, in the amount of \$120,154.54 (plus GST); and
  - (b) In the amount of \$133,046.69 (plus GST) in respect of the balance, which amount the Applicants claim represents a proportionate amount of such work relative to the capital contributed to the Scheme Property of the AIF, relative to the capital contributed to the Other Funds.
3. John Richard Park and Ginette Dawn Muller have applied to the Supreme Court of Queensland for an order that their remuneration and expenses in the winding up of LMIM (as may be approved from time to time), be borne by the AIF and the other funds of which LMIM is the responsible entity or trustee, in a proportion to be determined in the same manner as that which the Court directs the remuneration be borne and paid in respect of their role as liquidators of LMIM from 1 August, 2013, to 30 September, 2015.

The application is set down for hearing on 22 February, 2016.
